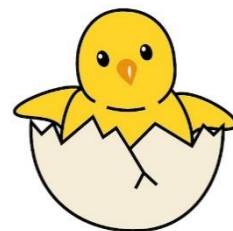

CLASSES: 10am start

Class 1A: Easter Bunny X-poles/bottom hole. Competitors may be led with the lead rein attached to the pony's noseband. Competitors entering this class may not enter any other classes.

Class 1B: Easter Chick X-poles/bottom hole. Competitors may be assisted in the Arena but not led.

Class 2: Easter Eggs 40cm. Competitors may be assisted in the Arena but not led.

Class 3: Spring Scramble 50cm. Competitors may be assisted in the Arena but not led.

Class 4: Easter Basket Eggstravaganza 60cm. Assistance not allowed.

Class 5: Eggciting 70cm. Assistance not allowed.

Competitors may enter no more than two classes per pony which must be consecutive. All Classes will consist of a first round and then a timed jump off round to decide the top placings

Rosettes will be given to the first 6 individuals in each Class.

Special prize for the winner of class 1B kindly donated by Henhaw Arena.

The winner of each Class will receive an Easter Egg!

Mini eggs for all competitors!

Mounted prizegiving as soon as possible after the end of each Class

The Judges' decision is final.

Approximate times will be put up on our Branch website once class entries are confirmed.

Dress code is as outlined in the Pony Club Show Jumping rulebook 2024. Hats must be tagged with a pink hat tag. You can have your hat tagged on the day.

Full refunds for withdrawals will be given up to the closing date. The booking fee is non-refundable.
