CLEAR ROUND JUMPING SATURDAY 7TH March: Class 12

Please note that we go down in height during the day ie we start with the 1m class and finish with the X Poles. Assistance is allowed in the arena.

The clear round jumping will follow on from the Tetrathlon competitors in that Class and the heights will be the same as for the Tetrathlon ie:

- Class 12A: Maximum 1m
- Class 12B: Maximum 90cm
- Class 12C: Maximum 80cm
- Class 12D: Maximum 60cm
- Class 12E: X poles and straight planks (competitors may be led)

For Tetrathlon Competitors, your show jumping round is included in your Tet entry fee so you don't need to enter the clear round as well unless you want a second round. Please note that your first round counts for your Tetrathlon score.

Times will be given out in advance although if anyone wishes to enter an additional round on the day we may be able to accommodate, time permitting.

Clear round entry fee is £9. Rosettes given for all clear rounds.

For the Geriathlon: Class 10

This is a team competition for adults only and there must be four members in each team. Each team member competes in one discipline only. Competitors must either be past Pony Club members or Family of current PC members.

Reasonable Adjustment:

TETRATHLON ENTRIES:

ALL AGES OF COMPETITORS TO BE TAKEN AS AT 1ST JANUARY 2026

Class 1	Open/Intermediate Boys	Boys under 25 years Showjumping max 1m. Shoot one handed, distance 10m, turning targets. Run 2000m swim 3mins.
Class 2	Open/Intermediate Girls	Girls under 25 years. As class 1 except run 1500m
Class 3	Junior Boys	Boys aged 14 years and under Showjumping max 90cm. Shoot one handed, distance 7m, turning targets. Run 1500m. Swim 3mins.
Class 4	Junior Girls	Girls aged 14 years and under As class 3 above
Class 5	Mini Boys	Boys aged 11 years and under Showjumping max 80cm. Shoot two handed, distance 7m, turning targets. Run 1000m. Swim 2mins.
Class 6	Mini Girls	Girls aged 11 years and under As class 5 above
Class 7	Tadpoles (mini mini) Boys	Boys aged 9 years and under Showjumping max 60cm. Shoot two handed, distance 7m, static targets. Run 1,000m. Swim 2 mins.
Class 8	Tadpoles (mini mini) Girls	Girls aged 9 years and under As class 7 above
Class 9	Beanies Boys & Girls	Boys/Girls aged 7 years and under Showjumping X-poles and single planks. Throwing beanbags onto target. Run 500m. Swim 2 mins.
Class 10	Geriathlon (mixed gender) ADULT CLASS	Parents/Guardians/past PC members. Team of 4 Team members to complete ONE phase each. Showjumping max. 80cm Shoot one handed, distance 7m, turning targets. Run 1000m. Swim 2mins.
Class 11	Open Biathlon (Open to Non Pony Club Members)	Individual competition (no teams) Run and swim as per age group. Section A under 8s, Section B 8-10 years, Section C 11-13 years.
Class 12	Clear round	Heights as per Tetrathlon classes
Classes 14-21	Late addition: Triathlon classes	Shoot, run, swim as per Tet Classes 1-8 above.

Provisional/Approximate Timetable is as follows (liable to change depending on entry numbers)

Saturday:

- Ride: 9.30am – Open/Int (1m) followed by Juniors (90cm), then Minis & Geris (80cm), then Tadpoles (60cm) then Beanies (x poles/bottom hole).
- Bean Bags: Before the Beanies ride time

Sunday:

- Shoot: 9.00 Open & Int/Juniors & Geris/Minis/Tadpoles
- Run: 10.30 Open & Int/Juniors/Minis & Geris & Biathlon Section C/Tadpoles & Biathlon Section B/Beanies & Biathlon Section A
- Swim: 12 noon Open & Int/Juniors/Minis & Geris & Biathlon Section C/Tadpoles & Biathlon Section B/Beanies & Biathlon Section A

PLEASE READ THESE RULES VERY CAREFULLY BEFORE ENTERING:

REFUND POLICY: Full refunds (minus booking fee) for withdrawals will be given up until the closing date of Friday 27th February. After that date no refunds will be given.

SATURDAY

RIDING:

- All classes will be held at Felbridge Showground in the Bill Kear (fibre) Arena.
- For classes 7, 8 & 9 (Tadpoles & Beanies) the course will only use half of the arena.
- PC UK Tetrathlon Arena Jumping rules 2026 apply (Appendix C in Rule book).
- There will NOT be either a Slip Rail or a Gate and rounds will NOT be timed.
- No horse/pony may be ridden more than twice in any age group. Please inform the Steward if a horse is to be ridden twice.
- Beanies may be led but this will be penalised by 400 points
- Beanies and Tadpoles may be assisted in the SJ arena but this will be penalised by 200 points
- Outside assistance will be penalised as follows:
 - Beanies & Tadpoles - 100 points
 - Minis - 200 points
 - Juniors & Seniors - elimination
- You may 'jump down' a class but this will be penalised by 400 Points. **If you wish to jump down a level, please put in the comments box when entering because this will affect your jumping time.**
- **If you are sharing a pony please state who you are sharing with in the comments box when entering.**
- The Pony Club Vaccination Policy 2026 will be used. Please have your passport with you at tack check in case of random checks.
- You will need to print off your riding number and bring a number bib. There will be a template on Pony Club Results where you will find your times
- Hats must be tagged with pink hat tags
- Body protectors must meet BETA 2018 Level 3 standard (blue and black label)
- Excessive use of the whip or misuse of spurs will result in disqualification.
- Riders may only wear spurs if they have passed the Spurs Test or C+ Test or above. Yellow hat tag must be worn as evidence.

BEAN BAG THROWING:

- Bean bag throwing for Class 9 will take place **BEFORE** their ride time, upstairs in the Felbridge Clubhouse.
- Each child will be allowed two practice beanbags and then ten throws onto a target on the floor.
- Throwing distance minimum 3m.

PLEASE READ THESE RULES VERY CAREFULLY BEFORE ENTERING:

SUNDAY

SHOOTING:

- Guns MUST be kept in their case AT ALL TIMES and may ONLY be taken out to place on the shoot table when instructed by the Range Steward. Please ensure the gun is serviceable.
- Loaders (if required) must be over 18 years of age and experienced at loading.
- Guns must be carried on site by a person over 18 years of age. If left in a vehicle guns should be locked in the boot.
- Protective or prescription glasses are compulsory for competitors shooting at 7m and recommended for those shooting at 10m.
- Long trousers must be worn
- Substantial shoes should be worn eg trainers. They must not reach the anklebone ie no riding boots
- Competitors MUST have shooting experience and be minimum 8 years old on the day.
- Competitors will be given one practice target and two competition targets – five shots per target.
- **If you are sharing a gun please state who you are sharing with in the comments box when entering.**

At firing points, all mobile phones and any other type of communication system must be silenced and out of sight. Elsewhere in the range environment, mobile phones should be silenced and may not be used to photograph or view competition targets on the range. This applies to athletes, officials, spectators and all other persons with no exception.

All competitors, siblings & spectators must be quiet in the Sports Hall waiting area. Any children running around will be asked to leave.

RUNNING:

- The run may be held either on grass or on astroturf – we will confirm nearer the time. Distances may be shortened in the event of bad weather conditions for the safety of the children.
- Run numbers will be provided.
- Running with a competitor or acting as a pacemaker will be penalised by a 30 second penalty for each breach of the rule

SWIMMING:

- Beanies & Tadpoles may wear arm bands or use woggles but no flotation jackets are allowed. Woggles must not interfere with the swimmer in the next lane.
- Only one poolside supporter per child is allowed at the end of each lane.
- Competitors may either start in the pool, from the edge or on the starting blocks.
- Swimmers diving from the poolside must have achieved the ASA Preliminary Competitive Start Award and swimmers diving from starting blocks must have achieved the ASA Competitive Start Award. Certificates must be uploaded when entering.
- Competitors must make sure they touch both ends of the pool when turning.
- **If your child needs an outside swim lane please state in the comments box when entering.**
- Pool length is 17m.
- There will be a lifeguard on duty.
- Swimming distances will be posted on a flipchart at the pool immediately after each wave. Please check these before leaving the pool as distances cannot be queried afterwards.

Please do not enter the swimming pool area with outdoor shoes and please do not abuse the facilities in the changing rooms, leaving them clean and tidy.

ENTRIES:

All entries to be made through Entrymaster. Tetrathlon Team Managers to confirm Team & Individual entries by email to oldsurreyburstow@pcuk.org. They will also need to confirm that their members are safe to shoot. Pony sharing/jump down/gun sharing/swim outside lane information **MUST** be advised to us **BEFORE** the closing date so that we can arrange ride times, shoot details and swim lanes accordingly.

ENTRY FEES:

Classes 1-9 & 12-21 Pony Club Members only.

Classes 1-8 £44

Class 9 Beanies £37

Class 10 Geriathlon £48 per team of four. Must be family of current members or past PC members.

Class 11 Biathlon (run & swim) £15. This class is open to all within the specified age groups.

Class 12 Additional clear round: £9

* LATE ADDITION* Classes 14 – 21 Triathlon (shoot, run, swim) £34

Fees includes First Aid.

AWARDS:

Rosettes will be given to the first 6 Tetrathlon teams in each age group and first 6 individuals in each class, rosettes or medals for the best shoot, run & swim in each class and rosettes will be awarded for all SJ rounds with maximum points (1,400).

Team rosettes only for the Geriathlon. Individual rosettes only for the Biathlon & Triathlon.

We will make up mixed Branch teams for children who are not in a Branch Team. Mixed teams rank behind Branch teams.

Objections/queries to be made by the Team Manager only, to the event organiser or phase steward. Wherever possible any queries should be raised with the phase steward as soon as the discipline has been completed.

We will endeavour to display results as soon as possible and prize-giving will be approx. 45 minutes after results for each class are finalised.

HEALTH & SAFETY:

The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health & safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective everyone must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.
